Dates/ Location/ Game times/ Schedule:

Tue, Nov. 23rd, Wed, Nov 24th, Fri Nov 26th and Sat Nov. 27th. T, W & F—games run from 5PM—9PM. Sat—9AM till tournament is finished. **No games on Thanksgiving Day.** All games will be played @ Courts4Sports, 854 Reading Rd. (Rt. 42) in Mason, OH 45040. Schedule available no later than Sunday, November 21st @ 12noon. Directions are available on-line @ www.courts4sports.com.

Admissions/ Concessions:

- There will be a daily admission. Coaches (2 per team) and players do not pay.
- Concessions will be available for purchase

Tournament details/format

- 3 game minimum (pool play).
- **Home team** will provide CLOCK OPERATOR.
- **Visiting team** will keep the OFFICIAL BOOK
- **Winning team's coach is responsible for reporting game score on MASTER SCORESHEET** which will be posted @ gym. Be certain to post the accurate score!
- Teams provide game ball.
- 5-minute warm-up b/w games. Arrive 20 minutes prior to your start time!

Game rules/ details

- OHSAA rules except for exceptions noted
- 20 minutes running clock per half.
- Clock stops @ all timeouts, in the last 1 minute of first half and the last 2 minutes of 2nd half.
- Full-court pressure is permitted in grades 5 & 6 only. Pressing is NOT PERMITTED if up by 15+ points
- 3 minute half time.
- 2 minute OVERTIME period
- 5 time-outs per game (3 full, 2 thirty-second)
- 7 fouls per half till one & one. 10 fouls or more per half = double bonus

Special 4th grade rules

- No full-court pressing—ever.
- Free throws—12 foot vs. standard 15 feet.

Defense

- All teams are strongly encouraged to play man-to-man but it is NOT required.

Championship details

- Each division will have a championship game.
- Trophies awarded to champion and runner-up teams.
- Qualifying for championship game criteria—in order of priority:
 - W-L record in pool play
 - In the event of a tie in pool-play records, head-to-head is 1st tie-breaker
 - Point differential in games (+ 15 point max for a W or L) is 2nd tie-breaker
 - Coin toss is final tiebreaker.
